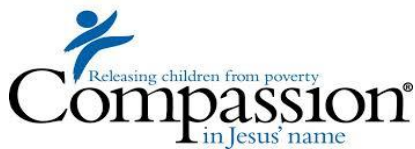
Huntly Foodbank
