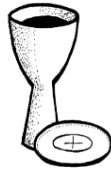

## Huntly Foodbank

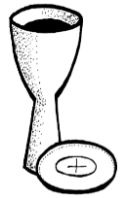
The following items would be greatly received by the foodbank:-
